## Mural brightens downtown art scene

Downtown will be more festive than usual Saturday as galleries throw open their doors for the monthly gallery crawl.

That's because this weekend also marks the debut of a new 30-by-80-foot mural on one of the exterior walls of the Viridian apartment building facing Downtown Presbyterian Church, at the corner of Fifth Avenue North and Church Street. The mural was created by Minneapolis artists **Isaac Arvold, John Grider, Eric Inkala** and **Drew Peterson**, all of whom will also be featured in **Twist Art Gallery's** latest exhibit, **Whole Milk**, opening just around the

corner in The Arcade with a 6-9 p.m. reception.

To add to the air of celebration, Downtown Presbyterian will be host to its monthly "Art-Luck" potluck dinner, happening concurrently in the courtyard area adjacent to the new mural.
